Covenant Living


Covenant Living is a private, not-for-profit organization providing housing options for seniors in warm, welcoming communities that support independence and active living.

Covenant Wellness Community

Covenant is reimagining how health care fits into everyday life. The Covenant Wellness Community integrates services where people live, work and age — making care more accessible, connected and effective.

The first phase of this bold vision for health care is taking shape in southeast Edmonton with Covenant Wellness Community — Lakewood.

At its centre is the Community Health Centre, a modern and inclusive hub that effectively shifts care out of hospitals and into the community. Here, people can access a variety of health and wellness services all in one place.

The health centre includes:

- medical and surgical clinics
- outpatient mental health
- diabetes education
- cardiac rehabilitation
- doctors' offices

- community spaces
- food vendors
- diagnostic and laboratory services
- health and wellness services
- primary care clinic

And this is just the beginning. The community will grow into a full-service campus designed for real life — seniors' housing, condos for young families and places to work, play and connect.

Covenant Wellness Community — Lakewood has the potential to transform how Albertans experience health and wellness by offering a practical solution to rising healthcare demands. It serves as a model for integrated, community-based care that can be adapted to meet the diverse needs of communities across Alberta.



Benefits to the community:



Primary care provides timely access to a patient-centred medical home within an advanced primary care framework.



Accessible community spaces foster active and engaged lifestyles, social connections and belonging.



Mental health and addictions care anchors recovery-oriented health and social supports where they are most needed to encourage early intervention and reduce emergency visits.



Urgent care works in tandem with primary care to effectively reduce emergency room wait times and allow patients to be seen in a more convenient location.



Outpatient medical and surgical clinics are relocated from hospitals into the community, creating access and additional hospital capacity.



Residential housing supports community renewal and resiliency for professionals, young families and aging adults.



Integrated seniors' continuing care offers an innovative approach to support active and engaged lifestyles and aging in place.



Medical retail services are conveniently situated together to promote access, co-ordination of care and smooth transitions in care.



Commercial retail developments offer community-minded services, foster connections and support economic stimulation.





Fastest way to add capacity to meet growing demands

To meet rising demands for hospital care, Covenant Health is planning two new inpatient towers — one at the Grey Nuns Community Hospital and one at the Misericordia Community Hospital.

The Alberta government has committed \$2 million to support the design phase. Each tower is expected to add up to 350 beds, helping relieve pressure on the system and improve access to care.

This is the fastest and most cost-effective way to add capacity without building new hospitals. These towers will expand acute care services in Edmonton and strengthen health outcomes for patients across Alberta. Planning is already underway, with a shared goal of opening both towers by 2029.




Rural health equity

Covenant is leading the way in building a mental health and addiction recovery system rooted in dignity, connection and hope.


