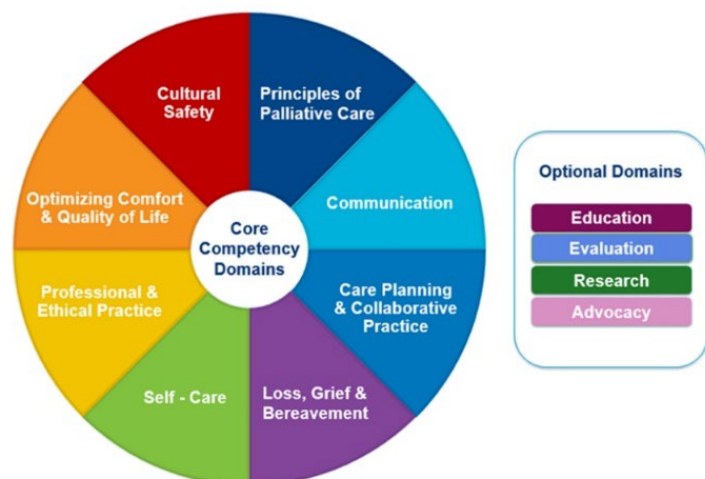

- Designed for all members of the interdisciplinary team, the educational suite contains interactive modules and palliative care scenarios across diverse settings.

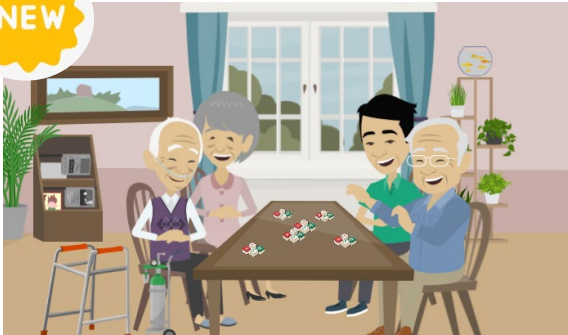
Palliative care is an approach to care that emphasizes quality of life for people living with serious illnesses.

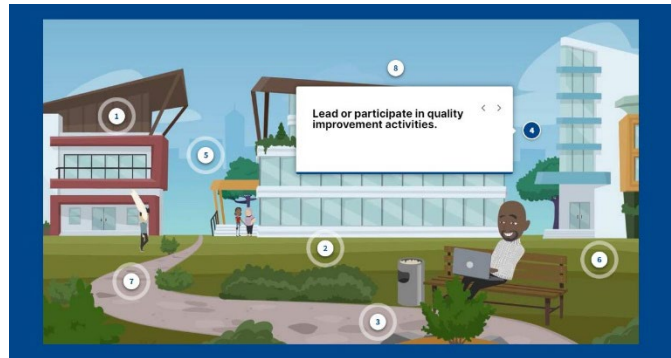
